- Private Lessons (casual) 30 min - pre-booking required. \$70
- Private Lesson (casual) 45 min - pre-booking required \$95
- Private Lesson (casual) 60 min - pre-booking required \$110

Semi -Private Lessons

- Semi-Private Term Lessons (9 x lessons for 2 -4 riders for 30 minutes
\$490 - per person)
- Semi-Private Lessons (casual) (2 riders for 30 minutes
- per person) \$60pp
- Semi-Private Term Lessons (9 x lessons for 2-4 riders for 45 minutes
\$660 - per person)
- Semi-Private Lessons (casual) (2 riders for 45 minutes
- per person) \$80pp
- Semi-Private Term Lessons (9 x lessons for 2-4 riders for 60 minutes
\$780 - per person)
- Semi-Private Lessons (casual) (2 riders for 60 minutes
- per person) \$95pp

Public Holidays - ARE included in your 9 week term and lessons will run on these days unless otherwise advised.

Discount - A 10% discount applies to a **2nd or more family** member when both members are enrolled for a **full term** and the first rider pays full term fees.

School Holidays - Forms for school holiday programs are available on request.

Bookings

- Please ensure your booking forms are returned by the requested date **WITH PAYMENT** to avoid late fees. Your riding position can **not** be held without payment received. New clients are not charged late fees.
- We require 48 hours notice for casual lessons. If you are not a fully paid term rider then you are considered a casual rider and your riding time is not held weekly.
- **Missed lessons are non refundable. The Showgrounds does not offer makeup lessons or refunds for missed riding lessons and has no obligation to do so.**
- Filled out forms received for bookings are considered tax invoices and money is due as such at the start of term or day of casual lesson.

What To Wear

- Shoes must have a flat sole and a small heel - no runners or blundstones allowed. Helmets must be Australian Safety Standards 3838 and be less than 5 years old. The Showgrounds have some sizes of boots and helmets available to free loan.
- Riders must wear long comfortable pants and tops with sleeves.
- Riders must remove jewellery and wear long hair tied back.

All riders must have read and be aware of our term and conditions, ask for a copy of these if you do not have one.
